Who's Who in the Cast

Jeff Harris (Director) Jeff's wide experience in theatre is always welcome in Grove Players, and we welcome him back to our organization. The last show he directed for us was You Know I Can't Hear You When the Water's Running. He is educated at Goodman School of Drama where he, as an actor, worked under such directors as Morris Carnovsky, Eugenie Leontovich and Edward Binns. For Grove Players he played Phillip Lombard in Ten Little Indians this past winter. He and his wife Muriel and their children live in Downers Grove. We are pleased to welcome this family man who plays a swinger so convincingly.

Jane McCullough (Connie) joined Grove Players during our production of Applause where she worked backstage on props. She made her debut on stage with us as Gymnasia in A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum this Spring. She is a member of the chorus in My Fair Lady

David Valenta (Buddy) comes to us from St. Francis Family Theatre and LaGrange Community in which groups he has played Paul Bratter in Barefoot in the Park and Buddy in Come Blow Your Horn. He was assistant director for the LaGrange group's production of Angel Street. He is employed by Joseph T. Ryerson and Sons in Chicago, where he lives. We welcome David to his first production with GP.

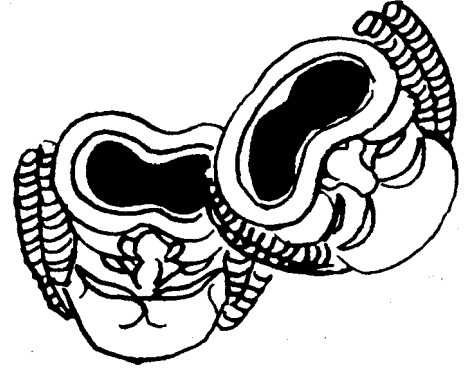

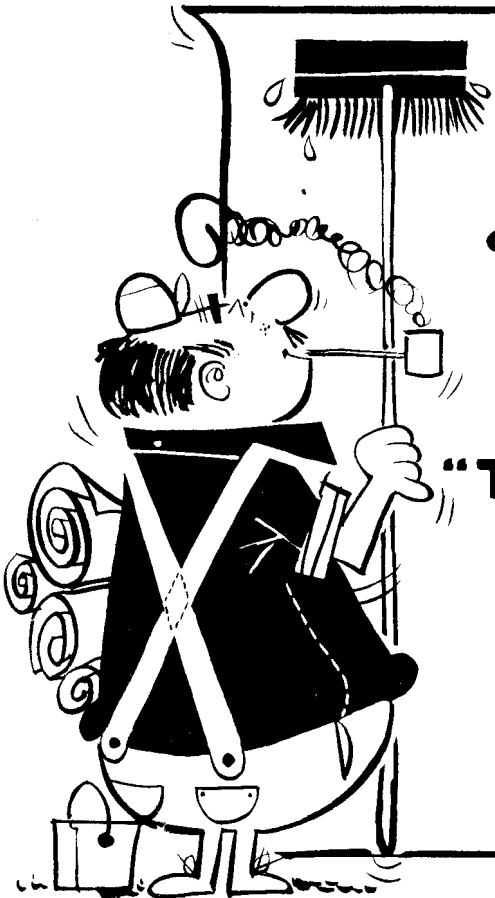
