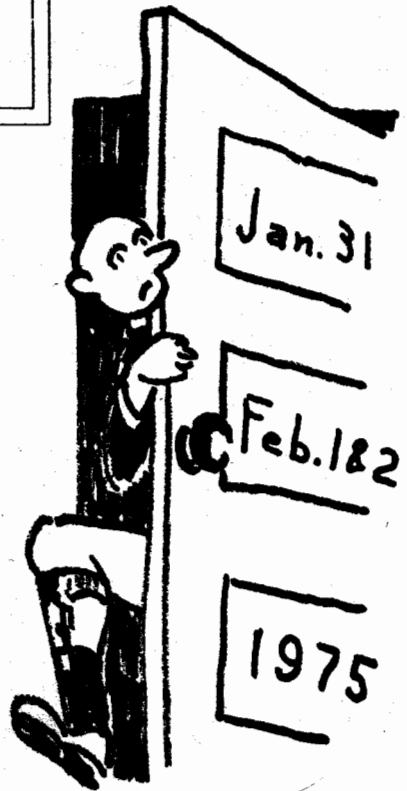

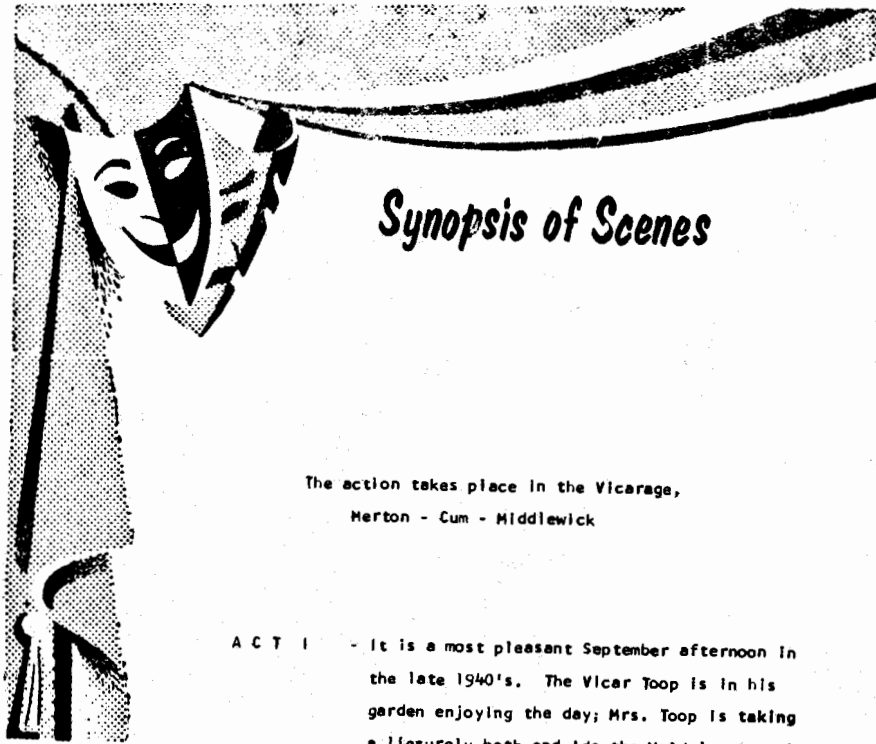

Ginger is well suited to the part of the maid. She is the mother of three active children- Laurie; Berry and Gretchen, who is two. So chasing a bunch of actors about is commonplace. While at K.U. she played Ado Annie in Oklahoma. This is her first performance since becoming a mother or "Big Bird" as she is often heard to say.
- MISS SKILLON** Pauline Gamble
This is Pauline's first performance with GP, but not her first stage performance. Ms. Gamble was Publicity Manager for Chicago Circle Players and acted in their productions of Look Homeward Angel; Lysistrata; Tartuffe; A Midsummer Nights Dream and Macbeth. While living in the East she was active in theater groups in White Plains and Yonkers.
- THE REVEREND LIONEL TOOP** Bill Robson
Bill was last seen, the back of his head only, as Music Director of Sound of Music. Mr. Robson's previous appearances were in GP productions of Don't Drink The Water, Barefoot in the Park; Applause and Funny Thing Happened On The Way To The Forum.
- RENLOPE TOOP (his wife)** Sandy Hill
Sandy is a happy homemaker taking care of a four year old son, Scott, and husband Ed. Aside from being a postulant in Sound of Music, this is her theatrical debut.
- CORPORAL CLIVE WINTON** John Lazarowicz
John has played a great variety of roles for GP over the years. We have seen him in Glass Menagerie; You Know I Can't Here You When The Water's Running; Sweet Charity; Luv and Barefoot In The Park. Some of us remember him as a Chinese Houseboy. Wonder if John recalls that part?
