Synopsis of Scenes

- Scene 2: Dr. Winston's office, 9 a.m.
- Scene 3: Toni's apartment
- Scene 4: Dr. Winston's office, afternoon of some day
- Scene 5: The record shop, afternoon a few days later
- Scene 6: Toni's apartment, early evening of same day
- Scene 7: Dr. Winston's office, the next day
- Scene 8: A small night spot, a few days later

Act II

- Scene 1: Dr. Winston's office, early the next morning
- Scene 2: The record shop, that afternoon
- Scene 3: Dr. Winston's office, later that afternoon
- Scene 4: A small night spot, that night
- Scene 5: Dr. Winston's office, the next morning
- Scene 6: Toni's apartment, that evening
- Scene 7: Dr. Winston's office, the next morning

Who's Who

Norman H. Wiegel (Director) - A speech and drama instructor at Triton College, Norm received his training at the University of Illinois and Northwestern University. Before his directing career, Norm acted for six Chicago-area community theater groups and three seasons of summer stock in Michigan and New York. Since then he has directed at the high school and college levels as well as for three community theater groups. Norm lives in LaGrange.

Bob Vonderohe (Producer) - Bob has lent his acting and vocal talents to GP's *Hello, Dolly!*, *Fiddler on the Roof*, and *Mame*. Plus, he appeared as Robert in GP's *Company*, Paul in *6 Rms Riv Vu*, and John the Baptist/Judas in *Godspell*, for which he also served as producer. A computer project manager, Bob and his wife, Mardelle, live in Downers Grove.

Patti Albaugh (Toni) - A nurses' assistant at Hinsdale Sanitarium and Hospital, plus a mother of two, Patti has had many roles in GP musicals. She was Louise in *Gypsy*, Marta in *Company*, Patti in *Godspell*, and a chorus member in *Fiddler on the Roof* and *Sweet Charity*. Also involved in GP road shows, Patti has studied dance with Laura H. Grant.

Dale Irvin (Igor) - Dale made his debut with Grove Players as Ito in the fall production of *Mame*. He attended the Forum Theater School and appeared in *Finishing Touches* and *God's Favorite* with Palos Village Players. A resident of Downers Grove, Dale is an advertising account executive.

Mardelle Vonderohe (Stephanie) - Mardelle appeared in GP's *6 Rms Riv Vu* as Janet, served as properties chairperson of *Mame*, and house manager of *Godspell*. She and her husband, Bob, have three children.

Carleen VanderKoy (Mrs. Durant) - An accomplished vocalist, Carleen, of Downers Grove, has been in numerous GP musicals including *Mame* as Mrs. Upson, *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* as Philea, and *The Sound of Music* as Sister Margaretta. She has also appeared in *Hervey* and *Lo and Behold* with the Players of St. Paul's United Church of Christ, where she is choir director.

Richard Albright (Julian) - A cast member of nearly every GP musical, Dick appeared as Oscar in *Sweet Charity* and Bill Sampson in *Applause*. He was also seen on the GP stage in *Anastasia*, *Don't Drink the Water*, and *Desk Set*. An actor in College of DuPage productions such as *The Miracle Worker*, *Promises, Promises*, and *How to Succeed in Business without Really Trying*, Dick has also worked with Wheaton Drama Club in *Nightwatch*. Dick is a teacher and lives in LaGrange Park.

Mike Walsh (Harvey) - Appearing with Grove Players for the first time last spring as Howard in *Picnic*, Mike has since then served as stage manager of *Godspell* and set designer of *Mame*. He participated in many plays with the Looking Glass Players, *Lebanon, Ill.*, and played King Pellinore in *Camelot* with the Camelot Players, O'Fallon, Ill. Mike, of Woodridge, attended Wilmington College, majoring in theater. He is a senior credit analyst with C.I.T. Corporation.

Carter Lamb (Señor Sanchez) - Carter portrayed Lazar Wolf in GP's *Fiddler on the Roof*, and M. Lindsay Woolsey in *Mame*. Living in Lemont and employed by Gooding Rubber Company, Carter was active in high school and church productions.

Joe Schiavo (Music Lover) - A commercial artist, Joe, of Downers Grove, designed the sets for last season's *Fiddler on the Roof*, *6 Rms Riv Vu*, and *Picnic*, and for several productions during the 1950's. He will be producer of GP's spring production, *Nightwatch*. Joe appeared on stage in GP's *Mame* as Babcock and in *You Can't Take It with You* as Paul.

Rick Russo (Customer/Waiter) - A student at Downers Grove North High School, Rick has appeared in many productions at the school including *The Crucible* and *Impromptu*, and in February, he will play Mr. Darling in *Peter Pan*. He also worked with the Soundsel Acting Troupe as director of *The Centerville Ghost* and choreographer of *Music Revue '77*. Rick made his debut with GP as a chorus member in *Mame*.

Karen Weber (Botticelli's Springtime) - A chorus member in GP's *Mame*, Karen was a thespian at Lyons Township High School where she received the Eleyne Pilant Memorial Award for Outstanding Contribution to Theatre for the class of 1975. A resident of LaGrange, she is a dental hygienist.

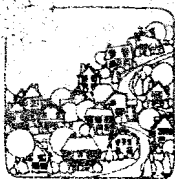
