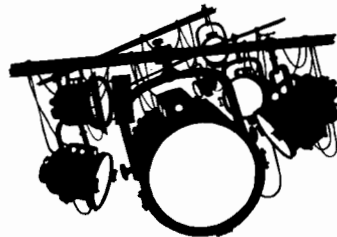

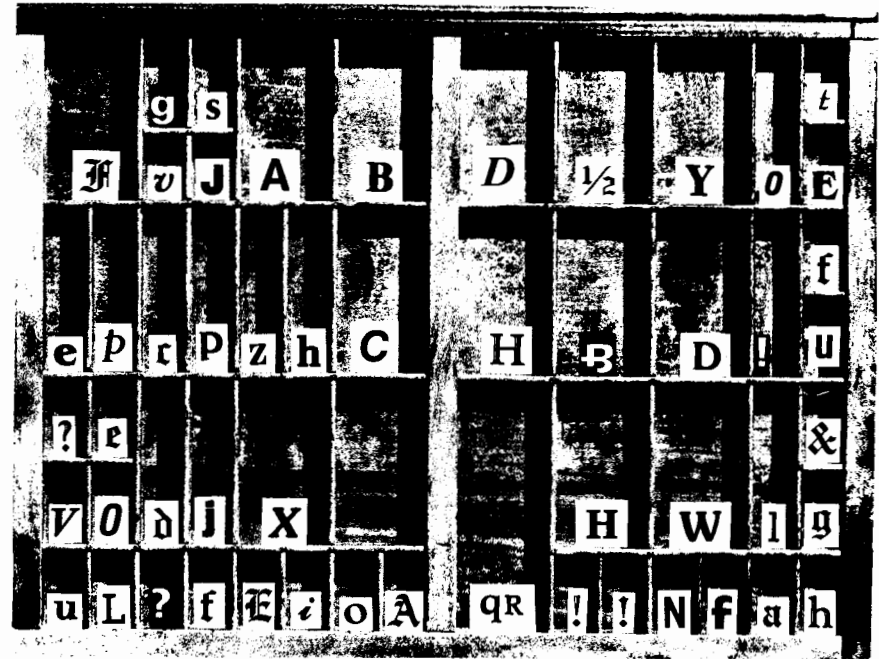

## WHO'S WHO

**JEFF HARRIS (Director)** Jeff grew up in Downers Grove, the son of Bill and Ginny Harris, who were members of Grover Players since 1946. He graduated from the Goodman Theatre School of Drama and was a staff member there between directing jobs. He now runs his own scenic shop, Paper Moon Productions, Inc., which specializes in industrial theme parties and displays. Formerly the resident designer at Marriott's Lincolnshire, his set designs were seen in productions of **Baby, Brigadoon, Chicago, Gypsy** and **Windy City**. Jeff's directing credits include **Man of La Mancha, Sleuth, Westside Story, Company, Chicago**, and for Grove Players **Deathtrap, Kiss Me Kate, The Lion in Winter** and **Cabaret**. Jeff lives in Des Plaines with his wife, Barbara, and their four children.

**THERESA A. MCSWIGGIN (Assistant Director)** As President of Grove Players, Theresa never ceases to amaze people with her enthusiasm and dedication. She has been assistant director for productions of **Deathtrap, Brigadoon, Follies** and **Gypsy** as well as producer for **Imaginary Invalid, Close Ties** and **The Uninvited**, all for Grove Players. Having served Grove Players as ticket chairman for 4 years, she has also worked on countless crews and committees and has even found time to appear in **Follies** as Young Stella and **The Uninvited** as Mrs. Jessup. Theresa resides in Downers Grove and is employed by the University of Illinois College of Dentistry as a research specialist in the Periodontal Research Center.

**GEORGE SCANLAN (Joe Keller)** While tonight's performance marks his debut with Grove Players, George has numerous credits in community theater. In Wayland, Massachusetts he was seen in **Harvey** as Elwood P. Dowd and **Carnival** as Schlegel for Vokes Theatre. Locally, he has appeared with West Wind Theatre in productions of **Much Ado About Nothing** as Antonio and **One Flew Over The Cuckoo's Nest** as Chief Bromden and with Tempo Players in **The Front Page** as Walter Burns, **Arsenic and Old Lace** as Jonathan Brewster and **The Rainmaker** as H. C. Curry. A resident of Elmhurst, George worked in several commercial film productions, including **Sixteen Candles** and **Date Night**.

**JAMES M. GILL (Dr. Jim Bayliss)** Currently Grove Players' Vice-President and Finance Chairman, Jim has become a valuable member of our group since his first performance on our stage in the 1985 production of **Imaginary Invalid**. He was stage manager for Grove Players' productions of **Close Ties** and **Gypsy**, ran lights for this season's **The Fantasticks** and handled assistant director's duties for last year's **The Uninvited**, in which he also portrayed Commander Brooke. Elsewhere, Jim appeared in **Mary, Mary**, and **Inherit the Wind** at the Summer Place and in Ad Hoc's **Antigone**. Jim is a Member of the Technical Staff at AT&T Bell Laboratories. He lives in Naperville with his wife, Fran Chessler.

**MARK IACOBAZZI (Frank Lubey)** Mark, of Westchester, is a familiar face to most Grove Players' audiences, having appeared as a chorus member in **Annie Get Your Gun, Oklahoma** and **Kiss Me, Kate!** and as Officer Brophy in **Arsenic and Old Lace**. For Tempo Players, he was seen in **Guys and Dolls** and **Mame**. A nuclear medicine technologist, Mark works as a review assistant for a health care company and, in his spare time, teaches a self-assessment course.

**JUDY HAMONTRE (Sue Bayliss)** A twelve-year member of Grove Players, Judy has compiled extensive credits both onstage and off. 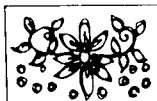

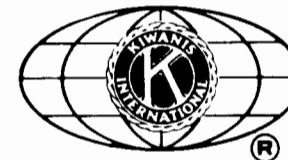
