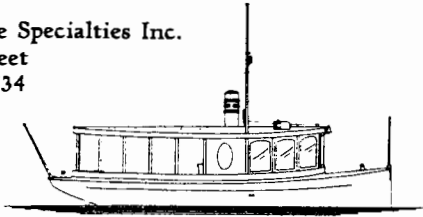

WHO'S WHO

Ron Jenkins (*Director*) Ron Jenkins portrayed Chief Bromden in GP's *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest* earlier this season. He also directed last season's production of *The Curious Savage*. Other recent directing credits include *Chicago* for the Beverly Theatre Guild and *Pack of Lies* for Palatine's Village Theatre. In July he will be appearing in *The Music Man* at Pheasant Run Theatre as a member of the barbershop quartet. Ron is the copy editor of *The Spotlight*, a new publication for theater enthusiasts of Chicago's Southwest Side, and he is happily married to his indispensable assistant director.

Jack Short (*Musical Director*) Jack is delighted to be back with Grove Players, having served as musical director for *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* last season. Other shows Jack has musical directed this season include *The Best Little Whorehouse in Texas*, *The Sound of Music* (twice), and *Stop the World, I Want to Get Off*. Future projects include *Something's Afoot*, *Jacques Brel . . .*, *George M!* and *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown*. During the day, Jack is a service representative for Hoam Products. Jack dedicates this production to his own "baby," Audrey Rose.

Janet Brooks (*Choreographer*) Although this marks Janet's first time as choreographer for GP, audience members may remember her as Tessie in *The Miss Firecracker Contest*. Other favorite roles include Catherine in *Waiting for the Parade*, Betty Meeks in *The Foreigner*, and Aldonza in *Man of La Mancha*. Her choreography credits are equally impressive, including work with Silver Dollar City, Country Music World, Tri-Lakes Community Theatre, and Corn Crib Theatre, all in Branson, Missouri, among others. Janet holds an MFA in acting from Western Illinois University and currently works with the Child's Play Touring Theatre as an actress/choreographer.

Karen Babcock (*Co-Producer*) *Baby* marks the second production that Karen has co-produced for Grove Players. She also co-produced last season's *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*. Karen has also proven herself as a valuable addition to a number of technical crews since joining the group a few years ago including props, set dressing, set construction, costumes and hospitality. Always ready to lend a helping hand, Karen has also been known to lift GP members' spirits with a seemingly endless supply of humorous cartoons.

Theresa McSwiggin (Co-Producer) Theresa last appeared for GP as one of the Geminae twins in last season's *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*. In her ten seasons with Grove Players, she has produced, assistant directed, stage managed, and/or designed the lighting for numerous productions. On stage, she has appeared in *Follies*, *The Uninvited*, and several road shows. Theresa is currently a member of the GP Board of Directors, serving as the Public Relations Director. She is employed by The American Academy of Periodontology as the program coordinator for the department of scientific, clinical and educational affairs.

Tracy Jenkins (Assistant Director/Ensemble) Tracy last appeared on the GP stage as Candy Starr in this season's *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest*. Other roles for GP include Fairy May in *The Curious Savage*, Ann in *All My Sons*, and Stella in *The Uninvited*. Backstage, Tracy has worked on almost every crew during her seven years with GP, most recently designing sound for this season's *See How They Run*. Currently she is on the Playreading Committee and has previously served four years on the GP Board of Directors. During the day, Tracy works for an investment firm in the Loop. She has enjoyed assisting Ron, her husband of three months, and hopes this is just the beginning of a lifetime of collaboration.

Tony Calzaretta (Danny Hooper) Tony has taken time off from an extremely busy schedule to make his first appearance with Grove Players. He is currently in his first year at the John Marshall School of Law and works as a clerk for a law firm as well. Tony also teaches dance and enjoys playing baseball, softball, basketball, and football. Previous stage credits include *A Chorus Line*, *Evita*, *Grease*, *The Wiz*, and *Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*, to name a few. Tony is an accomplished choreographer and will be adding to his list of credits in July when he choreographs *A Chorus Line* for the Des Plaines Theatre Guild.

Jami Griffeth (Pam Sakarian) Jami is pleased to be making her first appearance with GP. She spent nine consecutive months at Pheasant Run Theatre as a featured performer in *Comic Rhythms*, *First Impressions*, and *The John Gary Show*. She also appeared at Pheasant Run in *Grease* in the role of Rizzo. Other credits include Martha Jefferson in *1776* (twice) and Chiffon in Glen Ellyn's production of *Little Shop of Horrors*. Jami spends her workdays as a supervisor for a long-distance telecommunications company. She would like to thank her husband, Bill, for his encouragement. These performances are dedicated, as always, to Doug Quinn.

Barbara Harris (Arlene MacNally) Barbara has appeared in a number of shows at local theatres over the past few years, including *The Curious Savage*, *The Miss Firecracker Contest*, and *Pack of Lies*, all for Grove Players; *Supporting Cast* for Village Players in Oak Park; *Waiting for the Parade* with Ides of March Studio; and *Brighton Beach Memoirs* for Des Plaines Theatre Guild. She has also helped behind the scenes for a number of GP shows, including costumes for *A View From the Bridge* and set dressing for *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest*. Barbara is employed as the administrator of A.G. Bell Montessori School in Mount Prospect.

Darrell Heil (Alan MacNally) Darrell returns to the Grove Players' stage having previously appeared in last season's *A View From the Bridge*. Other stage credits include the sheriff in *Bus Stop* for the University of Colorado, Mr. Waldgrave in *The Nerd* for Village Theatre Guild in Glen Ellyn, Elwood P. Dowd in *Harvey*, Tom in *The Glass Menagerie*, and Jerry in *Zoo Story*, all for Arlington Players in Arlington, Massachusetts. Darrell enjoys swimming and softball and is employed by Dean Witter Reynolds, Riverwoods.

Dan Murphy (Nick Sakarian) Dan first appeared with Grove Players as Mushnik in *Little Shop of Horrors*. Other favorite roles include Billy Flynn in *Chicago* and Jeff Moss in *Bells are Ringing*, both with the Beverly Theater Guild, Charlie Davenport in *Annie Get Your Gun* with Beverly Hills University Club, and Rooster in *Annie* with Showcase Theater. The show that changed his life was the Beverly Theater Guild's *Li'l Abner* when he met his wife, MaryBeth. Dan serves as editor in chief of the new theater publication for the Southwest Side, *The Spotlight*.

Allison Whittier (Lizzie Fields) *Baby* is Allison's debut with GP although she has been active in musical theater for more than ten years. Her background includes two summer seasons at Sister Lakes Playhouse in Michigan, where she played Sandy in *Grease*, Lucy Van Pelt in *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown*, and Sonja in *Godspell*. Other favorite roles include Annie Oakley in *Annie Get Your Gun*, Princess Winifred in *Once Upon a Mattress*, and Charity Barnum in *Barnum*. Locally, she was last seen in Tempo Players' production of *Jerry's Girls*. Allison currently lives in Wrigleyville and is employed as a writer for a public relations/marketing firm in Oak Brook.

Nancy Belda (*Ensemble*) Nancy has appeared previously on the GP stage as Laura Fletcher in *On Blue Mountain*. For Circle Theater in Forest Park, she played the principal role in *Whatever Happened to Baby Jane*, a musical revue. She has also appeared locally in *Heirlooms* and *Wings*, as well as worked on lighting, make-up and other technical positions for the Theatre of Western Springs. Nancy is a retired registered nurse who owns and operates a Downers Grove-based calligraphy business. She enjoys singing for weddings, tennis, and cooking "gourmet type" foods.

Karen Bronson (*Ensemble*) Karen has been active in all aspects of theatre for many years. She last appeared on the GP stage as Domina in *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*. Other Grove Players roles include Carnelle in *The Miss Firecracker Contest*, Princess Winifred in *Once Upon a Mattress*, Evelyn in *Close Ties*, and Carlotta Champion in *Follies*. She has also worked with various other theatre groups appearing in such roles as Birdie in *The Little Foxes*, Reno Sweeney in *Anything Goes*, the housewife in *Working*, and Eve in *Waiting for the Parade*. Karen has been a longtime member of Grove Players, is a past Board member, and currently serves on the Playreading Committee.

James M. Gill (*Ensemble*) Jim recently appeared as Dale Harding in Grove Players' *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest* and Pseudolus in *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*. He has often worked backstage, as well as before the footlights, as assistant director, stage manager, and on light and sound crew. Other roles include Jim Bayliss in *All My Sons*, Peter Kroger in *Pack of Lies*, and Andrew in *Beyond Therapy*. Jim's most recent hobby is raising worms in his basement. He would also like to say that he hopes Darrell Heil has had as much fun playing Barbara Harris' husband as he did during *Pack of Lies*.

Tony Kortas (*Ensemble*) Tony joins Grove Players for the first time, bringing with him much experience with other local theatre groups. Previous roles include Romeo in *Romeo and Juliet* for the Semi Classical Players of Palatine, Mac Sam in *The Miss Firecracker Contest* for Harper College, and Master Nick Cricker in *The Mystery of Edwin Drood* for Des Plaines Theatre Guild, among others. He is also founder and artistic director of Plays for Living, an educational theatre troupe. Tony works as a waiter at Braxton Seafood Grill in Oak Brook and enjoys spending time with his wife, Rae.

Carter Lamb (*Ensemble*) In his 15+ years of involvement in community theatre, he has done such favorite roles as Tevye in *Fiddler on the Roof*, Doolittle in *My Fair Lady*, Senex in *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*, and Inspector Levine in *Catch Me If You Can*. He participates in the annual Joliet Kiwanis Charity Show and is involved in the drama ministry of his church. When he is not performing, you can find him doing set construction for GP on a regular basis. Carter will be "Father of the Bride" twice this year when his twin daughters get married, as well as become a first-time grandpa when his son's baby is born.

MaryBeth Murphy (*Ensemble*) MaryBeth began dance lessons at the age of 5 and auditioned for her first musical at 14. Since then she spent six years as a dance instructor, performed with the Diana Dancers throughout the Chicago area, and appeared in several musicals for a number of local groups including the Beverly Theatre Guild, Beverly Hills University Club, 99th Street Summer Theatre and Players Summer Theatre. MaryBeth is appearing for the first time on the GP stage where she joins her husband, Dan. She is currently employed as a legal secretary and recruiting coordinator for a downtown Chicago law firm.

Scott Neidl (*Ensemble*) This is Scott's first production with Grove Players. Previously he has worked as vice president and founder of Dare To Dream Productions in Rolling Meadows where he will be directing *Bleacher Bums*. He is also a founder of the Chicago based troupe, Plays For Living. Additional performance credits include *The Mystery of Edwin Drood* and *E.R.*, both for Des Plaines Theatre Guild. Scott has tried his hand at directing for the Des Plaines Theatre Guild as well, having worked on *The Elves and the Shoemaker*. During the day, Scott works as a waiter/bartender.

Robin Solomon (*Ensemble*) As a recent first time mother to six-month old ReBecca, Robin can really appreciate *Baby*. Since graduating with a major in communications and a minor in theatre from Illinois State University, She has been seen in *Bye, Bye Birdie* at Theatre on the Lake and *Dames at Sea* with the Des Plaines Theatre Guild. Robin has also worked backstage for a number of shows. She plans on continuing to participate in theatre as well as raise a family and hold a full-time job. Robin would like to thank her husband and "Becky's Grandma" for all of their help so she could be in this show.


