WHO'S WHO

Marge Uhlarik (Director) This marks the eighth time Marge has directed a GP production. The others were *The Miss Firecracker Contest*, *Pack of Lies*, *The Uninvited*, *Close Ties*, *My Three Angels*, *Once Upon a Mattress*, and *Our Town*. Other recent directing credits include *Waiting for the Parade* and *Beyond Therapy*. She has also appeared on stage with Grove Players, most recently as Beverly in *The Shadow Box* and as Kate in *All My Sons*. She currently resides in Chicago, where she is founder and teacher at the Ides of March Studio.

Maxine Wallis (Assistant Director) Maxine has appeared in six GP musicals, the first being *Annie Get Your Gun* 12 years ago. Since then, she has appeared in *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*, *Kiss Me, Kate*, *Follies*, *Gypsy*, and *On Blue Mountain*, which she also choreographed. Maxine has also appeared in *Gypsy* and *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* with the Performing Arts Theatre Company and in *The King and I* with Summer Place in Naperville. In addition to choreographing several GP road shows, she has danced in numerous variety shows in the Joliet area. She is currently serving as the director and instructor for the American Pride Clogging Team. Maxine works as a medical administrator in Western Springs and resides in Joliet.

Karen Bronson (Co-Producer) Karen majored in theatre at Illinois State University and has been involved in all aspects of theatre for many years. She has appeared in several community and professional non-Equity productions. Among her favorite roles are Carnelle in *The Miss Firecracker Contest*, Princess Winifred in *Once Upon a Mattress*, both with Grove Players, Birdie in *The Little Foxes* with Oak Park Village Players, and Reno Sweeney in *Anything Goes* with St. James Productions. Karen is a past GP board member and resides in Westmont.

Tom Manfredini (Co-Producer) Tom has been an active member of Grove Players for more than five years. On stage, he has appeared in GP's productions of *Follies*, *Gypsy*, *Little Shop of Horrors* (as Seymour), and *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*. Offstage, Tom co-produced *On Blue Mountain* and assistant directed *The Fantasticks*. He recently finished a four-year stint as the group's treasurer. During the day, Tom is a regional controller for EESCO, Inc.

Richard Albright (Dr. Spivey) Dick has been a member of Grove Players for more than 25 years. He has played lead roles in many GP productions, including Dr. Winston in *Cactus Flower*, Sheridan Whiteside in *The Man Who Came to Dinner*, Elwood P. Dowd in *Harvey*, Jules in *My Three Angels*, Lady Bracknell in *The Importance of Being Earnest*, and Mr. Kirby in *You Can't Take It With You*. He and his wife, Elaine are the parents of two sons, Tony and Joe. A retired English teacher, Dick is presently serving on the GP board of directors as Executive Producer.

Lise Bieritz (Nurse Flinn) Lise has been active in Grove Players for seven years, working on such committees as hospitality, props, costumes, and set dressing, and serving on the board of directors. Last season she was assistant director for *A View From the Bridge* and was seen on stage as a Protean in *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*. Lise is very happy to be returning to the stage this season in a female role! She and her husband, John, are the proud parents of Erick, 10, Emily, 8, and Ehren, 6.

Chuck Budach (Scanlon) Chuck has been a member of Grove Players for 30 years, during which time he has served on the board of directors, designed sets, and worked on set construction crews. He first appeared with GP as Metcalf in *The Solid Gold Cadillac*. Other roles with Grove Players include Mr. Webb in *Our Town* and Pseudolus in *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* (1974). With Melody Top, he portrayed the Commissioner in *Damn Yankees*.

Jerry Carlberg (Aide Williams) Jerry's first public appearance was in May of this year, performing in the Downers Grove Music Club's show, *A Journey Through the World of Music*, in which he sang solos, duets and choral pieces from opera and musical theatre. His first theatre performance was this summer in Naperville's Summer Place production of *My Fair Lady* as a member of the Ensemble. Jerry is currently working toward a B. A. in English.

Daniel Carlquist (Martini) An active Grove Players member, Dan was seen on stage last year as Dr. Emmett in *The Curious Savage* and as the Second Immigration Officer in *A View From the Bridge*. Previously he was a cast member of *On Blue Mountain*. Dan has worked on the stage crew for *Little Shop of Horrors* and the lighting crew for *You Can't Take It With You*, *Veronica's Room*, and *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*. He served as producer for *The Shadow Box* and is currently on the GP board of directors. A resident of Westmont, Dan is a graduate of Downers Grove South High School. He is currently employed as a project manager for the DiPaolo Company.

Joe Delaloye (Cheswick) Joe has acted with many area theatre groups. His favorite roles include Felix Ducotel in GP's *My Three Angels*, Victor Velasco in *Barefoot in the Park* and Erronius in *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*, both with the Performing Arts Theatre Company, H.C. Curry in Downers Grove Theatre Guild's *110 in the Shade*, and Selsdon Mowbray in Western Springs Theatre's *Noises Off*. He has also been an extra in several movies and television shows. Married and the father of four children, Joe is retired from Amoco after 30 years of service.

James M. Gill (Dale Harding) Jim has been an active member of Grove Players for the past seven seasons in various roles, including assistant directing *The Uninvited*, *The Miss Firecracker Contest*, and *The Shadow Box* and co-producing *A View From the Bridge* and *All My Sons*. This past summer, he assistant directed *My Fair Lady* at Naperville's Summer Place. Jim's acting credits include roles in *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum* (Pseudolus), *Pack of Lies*, *All My Sons*, *The Uninvited*, *Follies*, and *The Imaginary Invalid*. His educational background consists of "too much physics, not enough metal shop." Jim is employed by AT&T Bell Laboratories and lives in Lisle.

John Randy Hoel (Randle P. McMurphy) A newcomer to Grove Players, Randy has portrayed a variety of roles, including Jesus in *Godspell* and Milo in *Sleuth*, with the Glen Ellyn Village Theatre Guild, Bill Sikes in *Oliver!* with Circle Theatre in Forest Park, and Kolenkhov in *You Can't Take It With You* and Brian in *The Shadow Box*, both with the Oak Park Village Players. He played a postman on ABC's *Jack and Mike* and had the role of John in *Sing for Me, Naxhie*, named Best of the Fest at the 1990 Bailiwick Director's Festival. Among his directing credits is *'Night, Mother* with Circle Theatre. Randy and his wife, Melody, reside in Maywood.

Ron Jenkins (Chief Bromden) Although this marks his first Grove Players appearance, Ron is no stranger to the group, having directed last season's *The Curious Savage*. Recent theatre endeavors include directing and designing costumes for *Chicago* for the Beverly Theatre Guild and directing and designing the set for *Pack of Lies* for Village Theatre in Palatine. His next project will be directing GP's *Baby* in the spring. When he's not acting or directing, he enjoys collecting cereal boxes, playing the bass fiddle, and working as a proofreader for *Playboy* magazine. Ron will happily end 33 years of bachelorhood in January when he marries the lovely and talented Tracy Vonderohe.

Hank Kupper (Aide Turkle) Hank has been a member of Grove Players since 1973. He was most recently seen on stage as Mike in *A View From the Bridge*. Other GP roles include Mr. Lundie in *Brigadoon*, Alan in *Come Blow Your Horn*, Noah in *The Rainmaker*, and Lombard in *Ten Little Indians*. Hank owns an insurance agency here in Downers Grove.

Kathy H. Racine (Sandra) Kathy has appeared in many GP shows, including last season's *The Curious Savage*, in which she played Lily Belle. Other roles include Essie in *You Can't Take It With You*, Lydia in *All My Sons*, Pamela in *The Uninvited*, an ensemble member in *The Dining Room*, and Mama Rose in *Gypsy*. This past summer, she assistant directed *My Fair Lady* for Naperville's Summer Place. She has also acted in productions with Ad Hoc (including the title role in *The Mystery of Edwin Drood*), PATCO, Summer Place, and Playcrafters in Moline. A "cast member" at the Disney Store and Mickey's Kitchen in Woodfield Mall, Kathy is studying hotel and restaurant management at Joliet Junior College.

Sam Sakharia (Billy Bibbit) A newcomer to Grove Players, Sam has been acting for two years and plans to pursue acting professionally. He has appeared with the Des Plaines Theatre Guild as Eugene Morris Jerome in *Brighton Beach Memoirs* and as Hally in *Master Harold and the Boys*. He portrayed Michael in *Just One Day* with the Mount Prospect Players, and he can be spotted as an extra in the movie *Lucas* and as a cop in *No One Is Innocent*. Sam is a graduate of Prospect High School in Mount Prospect.

Robert Schramm (*Aide Warren*) A resident of Darien, Bob is another newcomer to Grove Players. At Southern Illinois University, he has appeared as Biff in *Death of a Salesman*, Whitney in *Stonewater Rapture*, Adam in *Mitts On*, Maxime in *Hotel Paradiso*, Brandon in *Talking Relationships*, and Dimitri Ivanovich in *Prison of Our Own Desires*. He is a student teacher and a football coach at Naperville North High School and will receive a physical education degree from SIU.

Ann L. Slivinski (*Nurse Ratched*) Ann's most recent acting credits include Nurse Thor in *E/R*, with the Des Plaines Theatre Guild; Agnes in *The Shadow Box*, Popeye in *The Miss Firecracker Contest*, and Barbara in *Pack of Lies*, all with Grove Players; Marta in *Waiting for the Parade* with Ides of March Productions; and Clara in *Marty* and Sara Brady in *Inherit the Wind*, with Oak Park Village Players. A graduate of SIU with a master's degree from NIU, Ann is employed as a speech/language pathologist for Oak Park Elementary Schools.

Tracy Vonderohe (*Candy Starr*) Tracy appeared on the GP stage last season as Fairy May in *The Curious Savage* and as one of the Geminae twins in *A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum*. Other roles include Ann in *All My Sons*, Stella in *The Uninvited*, ensemble member in *The Dining Room*, and the choruses of *Follies* and *Gypsy*. Tracy has also held many production staff roles, including assistant directing, stage managing, and lighting. Most recently, she co-produced *A View From the Bridge*. A resident of Downers Grove, she works for an investment firm in the Loop.

Conrad Raul Warren (*Ruckly*) This is Conrad's second appearance with Grove Players, having previously portrayed Brian in *The Shadow Box*. He was last seen in the Des Plaines Theatre Guild's production of *The Best Little Whorehouse in Texas* as Melvin P. Thorpe. Most of Conrad's dramatic experience has been with the renaissance faire circuit with the Sturdy Beggars in The Mud Show
